

Short CV of Dr. Michael Koch



After completing his master's degree in political science and English at the Carl von Ossietzky University of Oldenburg, Dr. Michael Koch worked as a research assistant at the University Institute for Economic Education in Oldenburg (IfÖB) from 1998 to 2004 and moved to the newly founded institute of the same name (IÖB) in 2005. There, he headed the departments "School Practice and Teaching Research" (2005 - 2008) and "Qualification and E-Learning" (since 2008) and was responsible for the overall project management of the institute from 2015 to 2019. Since mid-2019, he has been deputy scientific director and managing director of the IÖB.

In 2015, he completed a cumulative doctoral thesis at the University of Oldenburg on the framework conditions and design requirements of online-supported measures in the third qualification phase of teachers in economics education. This continues to be his research focus in the area of subject didactics.

The central aspects of his work over the past 20 years have been the creation of (digital) teaching and learning materials (including textbooks) and target content concepts for economic education, as well as the conceptualization, organization and implementation of Internet-based training and continuing education measures for teachers and other target groups throughout Germany and abroad. In this context, he has played a major role in the further development of the learning content management system ECEDON.

Since 2013, he has been co-editor of the journal Unterricht Wirtschaft & Politik (UWP). In addition, he is active as a reviewer for peer-reviewed journals. He is a member of the German Society for Economic Education (DeGÖB).
