

Short CV of Prof. Dr. Dirk Loerwald



Since mid-2011, Dirk Loerwald has been Professor of Economic Education at the Carl von Ossietzky University of Oldenburg (IfÖB) and, since mid-2019, Scientific Director and Managing Director of the affiliated institute IÖB. Since 2017, he has also been the scientific director of the digital Experimental Laboratory Economic Education (OX-Lab).

Prof. Dr. Loerwald is co-editor of the Zeitschrift für Ökonomische Bildung (ZfÖB) and the journal Unterricht Wirtschaft & Politik (UWP). In addition, he is active as a referee for various peer-reviewed journals. He is currently chairman of the board of the German Society for Economic Education (DeGÖB) and on the board of the Alliance for Economic Education in Germany (BÖB). In addition, Loerwald is a member of the scientific advisory board of the School of Education in Freiburg (FACE), the advisory board of the Landeszentrale für Politische Bildung in Lower Saxony, the center council of the Center for Lifelong Learning in Oldenburg (C3L) and the expert advisory board of the Foundation for Economic Education in Vienna.

The focus of his work is on education for sustainable development, financial education and consumer education, entrepreneurship education, business ethics-based economic education, class-room experiments, methodology of business education, digitalization, and teacher training.

The subject didactic research areas are in particular diagnostics of student performance (tests) and student conceptions (interviews/questionnaires), experimental intervention studies (teaching-learning laboratory), school experiment research (evaluation studies) and conceptual work on economic education.
